In order to prepare for Saturday's conference, here are a few steps to do ***before*** Saturday: (1) Setup a Twitter account (go to www.twitter.com or download the Twitter app); (2) Follow me - @Kristine_TX; and (3) Follow hashtag - **#NFPA_LeadershipConf**. Then, start Tweeting. Be sure to include **#NFPA_LeadershipConf** in your Tweets so others will be able to follow your contribution and questions/answers to the conversation.

You can simply say hello, ask questions, or if you're attending, share your experience with those who may be following the conversation.
